## Lab News

From September 12-14, Dr. Vieira hosted the first Dental CTSA Consortium meeting at the University of Pittsburgh. The event began Sunday evening and lasted through Tuesday afternoon. With over 20 attendees, the event was funded through the CTSA grant (Steve Reis, PI). Researchers were flown to Pittsburgh for the event, including two people from the National Institute of Health. Attendees came from schools all over the country, including Temple, Harvard, Baylor College of Dentistry, The University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio, UCSF, University of Iowa, University of Alabama and University of Michigan.

The consortium was held in an effort to form a nationwide collaboration to facilitate research in the field of dentistry. The consortium followed the model of the "sleep research network," with the initial meeting in Pittsburgh that catalyzed collaboration and the writing of several grants and papers. Due to the success of the consortium and the positive feedback from the attendees, this will most likely be the first of many meetings to further collaboration in dental research.
