That I will diligently uphold the dignity, honor, and objectives of the dental profession and, to the best of my ability, will contribute to its prestige, proficiency, and progress;

That I solemnly accept my responsibility to the patients to give them the best of my knowledge and skill, and to maintain an impeccable relationship with them that will warrant their trust and confidence;

That I will faithfully observe the principles of ethics set forth by the profession;

That I will lend my influence and support to dental education, to organized dentistry, and to all segments of the profession which contribute to the fulfillment of its purpose.

Seal of the University

The seal of the University of Pittsburgh combines the elements of the history and identity of the University. The shield is emblazoned with the checkered horizontal bar and three coins, which are heraldic symbols emblematic of William Pitt's family and fortune. The shield is taken from Pitt's coat of arms. The castle on the shield is a symbol of the concept of the city and is borrowed from the seal of the City of Pittsburgh. The banner below the shield is charged with the Latin words "veritas" and "virtus," "truth" and "virtue."



Academic Heraldry: The Symbol of Learning

The college or university commencement procession today, in this country and abroad, is a pageant, alive and bright with the dress and ceremony inherited from the medieval universities of the eleventh and twelfth centuries.

Academic life as we know it today began in the Middle Ages with Bologna and Paris, Oxford and Cambridge, Edinburgh, Glasgow, and Louvain, first in the church, then in the guilds. The teaching guild was the Guild of the Master of Arts, where the Bachelor was the apprentice of the Master and the dress was the outward sign of privilege and responsibility. The dress made visible, in color and pattern, the unity of persons of like purpose. Twelfth-century records of Oxford University carry this justification for academic dress: "It is honorable and in accordance with reason that clerks to whom God has given an advantage of the lay folk in their adornments, within, should likewise differ from the lay fold outwardly in dress."

The principle features of academic dress are three: the gown, the cap, and the hood. Their design and heraldry were from as early as the eleventh and twelfth centuries in the great European universities as an outward sign of the bringing together of students and privileged persons under the same discipline.

To preserve their dignity and meaning it became necessary for these universities to set rules for academic dress. American universities agreed on a definite system in 1895 and set up a suitable code of academic dress for the colleges and universities of the United States. In 1932 the American Council on Education presented a revised code which for the most part governs the style of academic dress today.

THE GOWN: The flowing gown comes from the twelfth century. Many think it was worn in olden times as protection against the cold of unheated buildings. It has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it completely covers any dress of rank or social standing underneath. It is black for all degrees, with pointed sleeves. For the Bachelor's or Master's degree, the gown has no trimmings. For the Doctor's degree it is faced down the front with velvet and has three bars of velvet across the sleeves in the color distinctive of the college. For example, the trustees and administrative officers of the University of Pittsburgh wear gowns trimmed in blue velvet edged in gold faille.

THE CAP: Under Roman law, a freed slave won the privilege of wearing a cap. And so the academic cap is a sign of freedom of scholarship and the responsibility and dignity with which the scholarship endows the wearer. Old poetry records the cap of scholarship as square to symbolize the book, although authorities claim that the mortarboard is the symbol of masons, a privileged guild. The color of the tassel on the cap denotes the discipline.

THE HOOD: Heraldically the hood is an inverted shield with one or more chevrons of a secondary color on the ground of the primary color of the college. The color of the facing of the hood denotes the discipline represented by the degree. Some of the colors are gold yellow (Science), light blue (Education), white (Arts and Letters), green (Medicine), and lilac (Dentistry). The color of the lining of the hood designates the university or college from which the degree was granted.
