**Filling Out Our History Answer:** C. Dr. Nicholas H. Bitar (DEN '28) was selected to head the Syria-Lebanon Nationality Room Committee in 1935. When the room opened in 1941, it was the sixth to be installed, joining the Czechoslovak, Yugoslav, Lithuanian, Polish, and Greek rooms. It was the only completely intact antique room to be installed in the Cathedral at that time.
