

Two of our students presented posters at the University Honors College Undergraduate Research Fair on April 8, 2015 at the William Pitt Union. Claire Sesson's poster was titled "Caries experience (DMFT/DMFS scores) may serve as an indicator to predict dental patients' overall health risk" and Andrew Ng presented "Pittsburgh as a High Risk Model: The Potential Savings of a Personalized Dental Care Plan". Data included in these projects come from the Dental Registry and DNA Repository (DRDR). The DRDR project is an IRB approved protocol that include approximately clinical information on 5,000 consented subjects. These data are available upon request to all SDM faculty, residents, and students.
