## Lab News

**The concept of exposure when selecting comparison groups for determining individual susceptibility to addiction to cigarette smoking** was published on April 19, 2019 in PLoS One. This case/control work is about smoke dependence and your risk factors and the aim of this study was to evaluate if selecting a comparison group that includes light smokers versus people that never smoked impacts the results of genetic association studies. Data were obtained from the Dental Registry and DNA Repository project (DRDR).
