




# Vieira Lab Newsletter

## Lab News

Two papers on oral health management in patients with depression were recently published in *Special Care Dentist* (<https://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/pubmed/29756655>) and *Clinical Oral Investigations* (<https://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/pubmed/30386995>) showing that certain dental treatments fail more often if an individual has underlying depression. Using data from the Dental Registry and DNA Repository comparing different types of treatments, we showed that composites and endodontic treatments fail more in people with depression, whereas amalgam restorations apparently are a good option for these patients.
