

Do you need a dental examination?



Fourth-year Pitt Dental Medicine students are screening adult patients for their dental licensure examination.

Every registered adult patient (age 18 and older) will receive a free screening for cavities, a limited dental examination, x-rays and a referral for a **free** comprehensive dental examination at Pitt Dental Medicine. Scheduled screening sessions will take place in Salk Hall on Wednesday afternoons from **November 13, 2019 to January 22, 2020**. Appointment times are from **1-4 pm**, and will last about 30 minutes to 1 hour. Qualifying individuals will be invited to serve as patients for the examination on **Feb. 6 & 7, 2020**.

Patients serving in this capacity may be eligible for free services including fillings and cleanings.
